This Act acknowledged the magnitude of this planning by providing pre-election transition support. Hence, the Readiness Project was the first transition effort to operate under this new framework.

The book Romney Readiness Project 2012 Retrospective & Lessons Learned is a candid and detailed account about what was done well, what could have been improved upon and lessons learned. It is hoped that future transition teams from both parties can benefit from reading this retrospective.


